Subject: Recognition of Central Board of Secondary Education as National Sports Promotional Organization (NSPO) for promotion of School Games – Reg.

Sir,

I am directed to inform you that Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports has recognized the Central Board of Secondary Education as the National Sports Promotion Organization (without grant of financial assistance) for promotion of games in CBSE Schools.

2. The CBSE should be primarily responsible for the development and promotion of sports amongst students of CBSE.
3. The recognition is granted on continued observance of following terms and conditions:

- (a) The Office-bearers of the organization shall invariably be appointed by election in accordance with the procedure laid down in its constitution.
- (b) The organization shall give advance notice of at least two months duration to Union Government for any change in its constitution. The copy of the existing Constitution and the proposed changes should invariably be sent along with the notice.
- (c) The organization must have accepted the Mercantile System of accounting and maintain its accounts in the Double Entry System. The Accounting Year should be from 1st April to 31st March. The books of accounts shall always be open to inspection by authorized representatives of the Union Government.
