

CBSE Aryabhata Ganit Challenge (AGC) Round II (10.11.2025): Important Instructions

Dear Principals,

With reference to Circular No: Acad-69/2025 Date: 19.09.2025, the details of Round II of online, Aryabhata Ganit Challenge 2025-26 are as follows:

Date	Time
10.11.2025	12.00 noon – 01:00 pm

1. The link of the test will be available on the official website of CBSE Academic Unit i.e <https://cbseacademic.nic.in/> on the above-mentioned date and time.
2. The school should ensure confidentiality and fair conduct of the test by not involving science or mathematics teachers as invigilators.
3. After login to portal using LOC credentials, encrypted question paper can be downloaded at **12:00 noon** and password to open question paper will be provided at the **same time**.
4. The total duration of the test will be **60 minutes** which will include downloading of the question paper, reading of instructions, answering the challenge and uploading the answer quiz.
5. Arrange desktop or laptops with following specifications for each round II registered student
 - a) Minimum 4 GB RAM (Preferable)
 - b) Broadband connection /Wifi /Datacard /Dongle
 - c) Adobe Acrobat Reader DC software installed
 - d) UPS backup for the computers/laptop
6. Allocate one computer for each student (on the date of the test) who has been registered for the second stage. The students **MUST** attempt the paper individually on their own.
7. Only registered students who have been selected for the second stage are allowed to appear
8. The students **have to mark** responses on the downloaded question file only.
9. **Important Instructions**
 - This is a PDF based test. Open the file in **Adobe Acrobat Reader** only.
 - All students have to attempt the test on downloaded PDF only.
 - Save and upload the completed PDF file with the same name.
 - Saved PDF should be uploaded by 1:00 PM (IST)
 - **DO NOT** print the question paper
 - **DO NOT** change downloaded file name.
 - **DO NOT** compress the file before uploading.
 - **DO NOT** scan and upload the file.
10. *In case of any problem in uploading, try to upload from another PC*
11. Answer sheets must be uploaded within the stipulated window and Schools must preserve exam recordings of CCTV till the declaration of results.
12. Technical footprints will be on record during the administration of this activity, and data scrutiny will be carried out. In case of detection of any unfair means during the data scrutiny, the results of such schools will be withheld, and the concerned school may be debarred from participation in the next cycle of AGC.
