

User Guide - Reading Challenge Portal

Note: Download button, Upload button and Password for PDF opening will be enabled at 12:00PM

Step 1: Visit the Portal via URL as given below

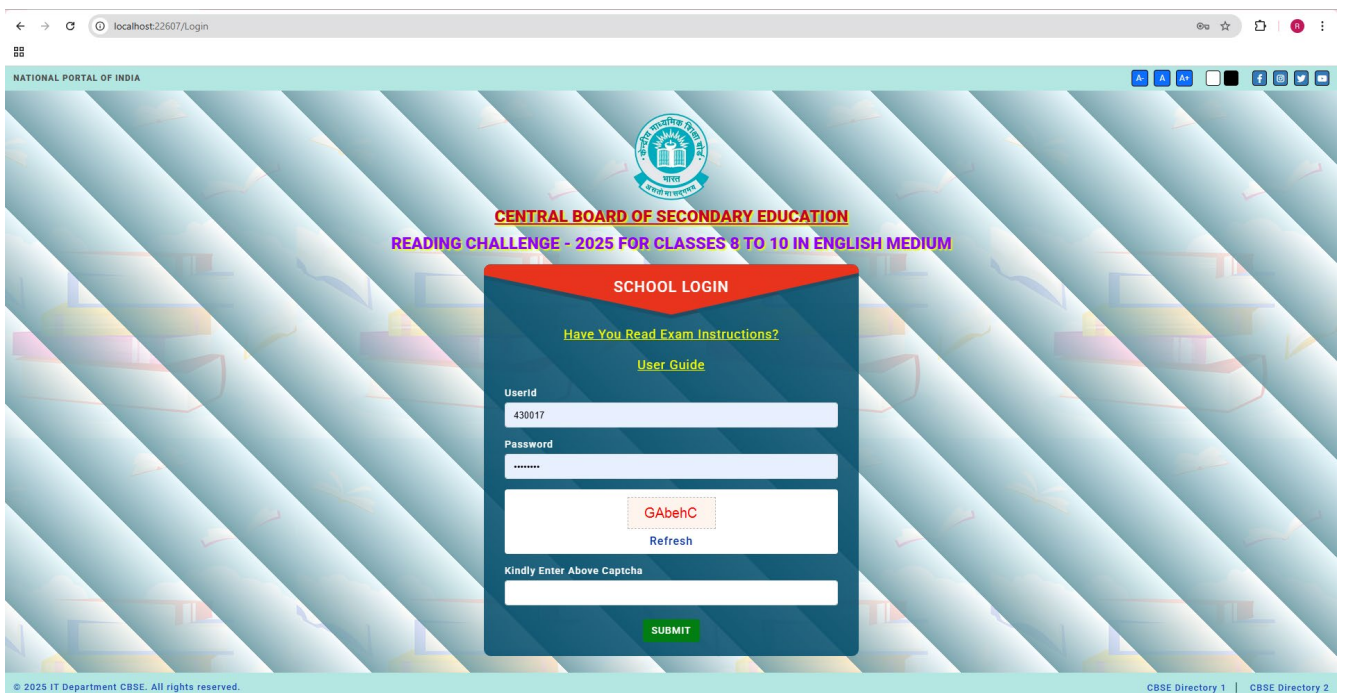

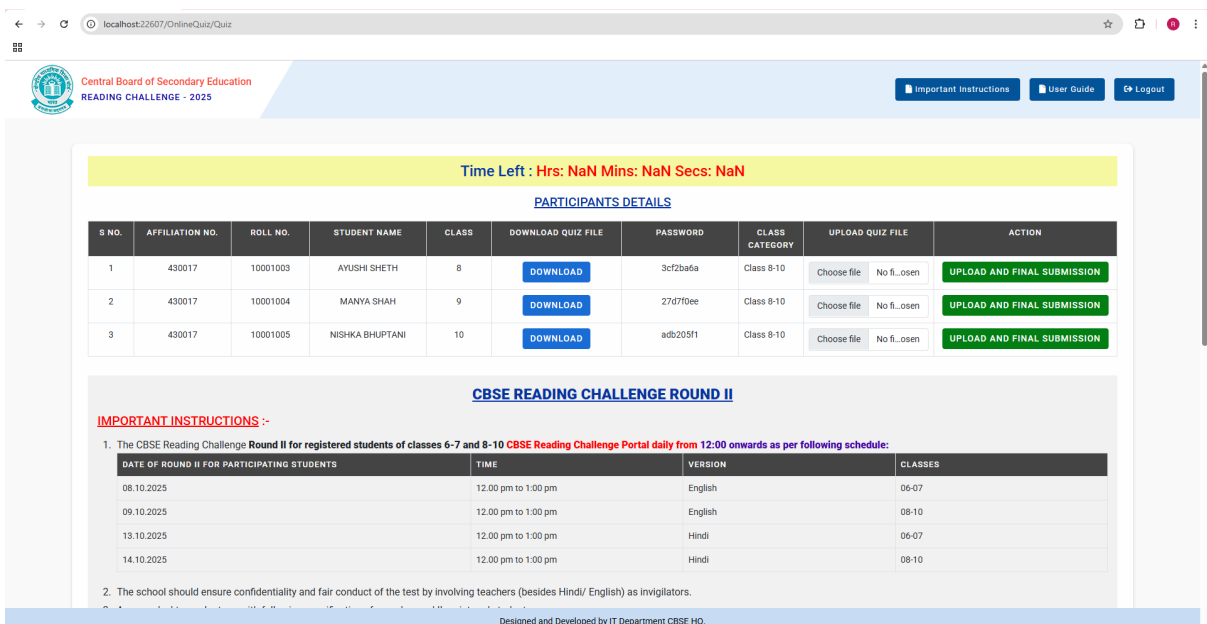
Step 2: Log in via (OASIS credentials)

- Enter your OASIS username and password.
- Enter the captcha for verification.
- Click Login.
- After successful login, you will be taken to the Home page.



Step 3: Download Question Paper

- From the Home page, go to Downloads.
- Click the file name or Download link.
- Save the file to your computer.



2. The school should ensure confidentiality and fair conduct of the test by involving teachers (besides Hindi/ English) as invigilators.

3. Arrange desktop or laptops with following specifications for each round II registered student

- High-speed internet facility (at least 25 MBPS)
- Medium to high configuration computer with at least 8 GB RAM
- Computer should have the latest configuration
- Google Chrome is preferred for best performance.**
- Adobe Acrobat Reader DC software installed
- UPS backup for the computers/laptop

4. Allocate one computer for each student who has been registered for the second round. The students **MUST** attempt the paper individually on their own.

5. Only registered students who have been selected for the second round are allowed to appear.

6. After login to portal using LOC credentials, encrypted question paper password would be provided at **12:00 AM**.

7. The test time would be **12:00 noon to 1:00 pm**.

8. The students **MUST** attempt the paper individually on their own.

9. **The total duration of the test will be 60 minutes which will include downloading of the Reading Challenge question paper, reading of instructions, answering the challenge and uploading the answered quiz.**

10. After the test duration is over, the portal will be closed. No grace time will be given for uploading answered paper.

11. Important Instructions

- This is a PDF based test.
- Open the file in **Adobe Acrobat Reader** only.
- All students have to attempt the test on downloaded PDF only.
- Save and upload the completed PDF file with the same name. On browser mode, Ctrl+S or right_mouse_click->Save as' may be used to save the pdf (With the same pdf file name).**
- DO NOT** print the question paper
- DO NOT** change downloaded file name.
- DO NOT** compress the file before uploading.
- DO NOT** scan and upload the file.
- In case of any problem in uploading, try to upload from another PC

12. Students are expected to upload the answered Question Paper file as soon as they complete answering the paper by ticking the option boxes of the questions.

13. Merit will be prepared based upon the accuracy of the answers and the shortest duration taken for submitting the final answer sheet.

Note : If you don't follow the instructions and deviate from the procedure, answer sheet of your students may not be evaluated.
